## Shop with Schoolpop

Go to [www.schoolpop.com](http://www.schoolpop.com) before you do your shopping on-line. There are several retailers (such as Wal-mart, Land's End and Dell) that will give the school a percentage of your purchase. All you need to do is register with Schoolpop and then shop! If you would like to sign up for a Schoolpop VISA, it is very simple. You can go to, call 1-800-297-1286 code 28B8, or pick up a form from Mrs. Miracle to apply for a Schoolpop VISA. When you use this VISA the school will earn 1% from your purchases wherever you shop. So, if you are using a credit card that does not pay rewards, please consider switching to Schoolpop VISA. If you already have a credit and don't want to switch, please consider registering at Schoolpop.com and going through them to make purchases online. We have in the past earned over \$1,000 with this fundraiser.

## Labels, Labels, Labels

Are you saving labels? Did you know that for every 1000 Best Choice labels the school will receive \$30? So be sure to cut off that UPC barcode off EVERY Best Choice brand package. And are you saving the Box Top coupons off of product brands like Betty Crocker, Pillsbury, Ziploc, Hefty, Yoplait, Bisquick, Cheerio's, Raisin Nut Bran, Chex and many, many more. Every Box Top coupon is worth 10¢. We are also collecting Campbell Soup labels (or barcodes). Campbell brands include Campbell's, Swanson, Prego, V8 and Franco American. Some of the products require the barcode to be kept and others require the lid. There is usually a Campbell kid beside the UPC that will let you know which is to be saved. These are all products that we all purchase from time to time, if we could just save the labels the school would benefit greatly. All these little labels can be turned into big cash!
