# Clinton Christian Academy-Board Notes

July 13, 2020

The CCA Board of Directors met in the CCA Cafeteria for their regular monthly business meeting on Monday, July 13. **Board members followed new COVID protocol (also being utilized for open gyms, tutoring, etc. this summer) upon entering the school.** The meeting began with the Opening Prayer given by Dain Sisk. Keith Carmichael shared a devotion. Prayer requests were shared. The minutes from June 8 were approved. The financial reports and bills from the month of June were reviewed and approved.

- Current enrollment for CCA is at 139 students, with 74 students in K4-4<sup>th</sup> grade, 20 students in grades 5 & 6, and 45 students in grades 7-12.
- Mrs. Ritchie reported that the DNR Grant for new pour-in-place surfacing has been submitted. If approved, this surfacing would be done over a period of five or six years with approximately \$30,000 (maximum grant amount allowed) worth of surfacing poured each year. Special thanks to Amber Hansen for her hard work in putting this grant together for CCA! Grant award recipients will be notified in August.
- CCA has been awarded the funds for the purchase of an AED through the GVMH Foundation.
- Summer projects are underway at CCA. The walls of the band/music room are underway for completion prior to the start of school. Studding up walls, insulation, sheetrock and painting are in progress. Logan Fuller is installing a new mini-split HVAC unit for the upstairs area. Carpet for the stairway areas is ordered and will be installed by Hobsons in August. The board has also approved the installation of a second exterior exit from the north end of the music room to be completed this summer if possible.

## BOARD ACTION

- Stephen Fisher was hired to fill the new full-time custodian's position for the 2020-21 school year. Mr. Fisher will be working from 10:00 am until 6:30 pm. Having a custodian onsite during school hours will be a blessing with all of the extra sanitization protocol in place for the new school year. Welcome to the CCA staff Mr. Fisher!
- Heidi Foreman was hired as a full-time teacher. Mrs. Foreman will be teaching HS English I, English II, and English III, and the *Take Flight* Reading Program.
- The Board approved a plan to be shared with CCA staff and parents which outlines the COVID protocol that will be put into place for the new school year. This plan will be sent out to CCA stakeholders next week.
- The Board approved purchasing touchless filling stations that will be installed at water fountains prior to the start of school.
