The CCA Board of Directors met in the CCA Art Room for their regular monthly business meeting on Monday, June 13. The meeting began with the Opening Prayer given by Jeff Lowe.

Kristy Bateman gave the devotion which focused upon how each one of us serve as Christian leaders, with the responsibility of being the light of Christ as we interact with others in our neighborhood, church or work place! JUNE BOARD ACTION & DISCUSSION

- > The Board approved a bid for carpet cleaning and waxing from Enviro-Dry Cleaning & Restoration for \$3635.21
- ➤ The Board approved the revisions to the 2022-23 Student/Parent Handbook after a second reading this month.
- The Board elected Board Officers for the new school year: Allen Huff, President; Keith Carmichael, Vice-President; and Kathy Harrison, Secretary.
- Mrs. Hyke updated the board regarding some technology recommendations for 2022 Summer and beyond. Recommendations included moving staff and students to use of the Google Suite, gradually (over time) moving to desktop computers for all staff in addition to Chromebooks purchased for interested staff, and moving the CCA Office files to Google Drive on a desktop computer placed in Mrs. Ritchie's office. These changes would be more efficient and cost-effective for the school.
- The administration reviewed the Spring Iowa Achievement Test data with the Board. CCA class average scores in K5-grade 10 were above grade level in all academic areas.
