January 9, 2023

The CCA Board of Directors met in the CCA Art Room for their regular monthly business meeting on Monday, January 9. The meeting began with the Opening Prayer given by Becky Hyke.

Kathy Harrison gave the devotion which was taken from Louie Giglio’s book, Don’t Give the Enemy a Seat at Your Table. Hopefully we will be ready to roll with spring activities!
- ❖ Mrs. Ritchie reported that advertisement for K4 and K5 Round-Up has begun. Round-Up is scheduled for February 3. Already we have many parents that have signed up to attend this event in order to enroll their child for classes next year! Yav God!

## JANUARY BOARD ACTION & DISCUSSION

- The Board reviewed and approved an increase in Substitute Teacher Pay to \$90 per day (formerly \$80 per day). This increase will be effective January 2, 2023.
- Staff intents were shared with the Board.
