The CCA Board of Directors met in the CCA Art Room for their regular monthly business meeting on Monday, June 9. The meeting began with the opening prayer given by Barry Bullock.

The financial reports and bills from the month of May were reviewed and approved. Prayer requests were shared.

- The administration reported that the tentative enrollment for next year is currently at 179.

The project was awarded to CISC, which is currently on-site at CCA working on the installation throughout the summer. This initiative marks an important advancement in enhancing campus safety.
- Mrs. Hyke updated the Board regarding the CCA Belize Mission trip scheduled for June 18-24. Ten team members from CCA will engage in a variety of ministry and service activities, including light construction work such as painting and repairing a church ceiling, door-to-door outreach, VBS, and hosting special events for women, men & youth as well as assisting with Sunday evening worship at a local church.
