

Academic Progress at CCA: A Closer Look at Our Students' Achievements


At Clinton Christian Academy, we are proud to observe a consistent trend of academic excellence among our students. Notably, our 8th graders are testing at levels typically seen in post-high school students, demonstrating the effectiveness of our advanced curriculum and small class sizes. Historically, CCA students perform one to two years above grade level, and while there may be minor anomalies, the overall assessment scores reflect significant progress.

As seen below, our 6-12th grades are 2+ levels above their current grade.


At CCA, we embrace a diverse range of academic abilities, welcoming all students regardless of their starting point. This inclusive approach allows us to support each student's unique journey.

By 8th grade, students achieve a maximum score of 13, illustrating the remarkable growth they experience during their time at CCA. This is equivalent to one level higher than 12th grade level before they even start high school.

Achievement Test Grade Equivalents






CCA Facility Enhancement Project: Investing in Our Future



How Clinton Christian Academy Compares to Other Private Schools
