- The Board approved the recommended revisions to the Parent Volunteer Form for 2026-27. This form will be sent out to families in May to complete for next year.
- Jeff Lowe updated the Board about the progress of the Capital Campaign Committee. The committee is grateful for those parents and staff members that have made contributions. The committee will be having a meeting to wind up the campaign on Wed., April 22 to discuss remaining donations that are needed to reach the \$4M goal. Architect Chris Ball and his team plan to have building specifications completed by the end of April and are hopeful that this project will go out for bid in early May.
