Clinton Christian Academy Board Notes

August 10, 2026

The CCA Board of Directors met in the CCA Art Room for their regular monthly business meeting on Monday, August 10. Mrs. Ritchie shared a devotion titled “Make Your Requests Known to God,” based on 2 Kings 19:14-15. Using King Hezekiah’s example, she encouraged the board to bring fears, pain, and difficult circumstances before God in prayer rather than relying solely on their own plans. The devotion reminded everyone that, through Jesus, we can approach God with confidence, trusting that He hears our prayers, remains with us in hardship, and works for our good.

The financial reports and bills from the month of July were reviewed and approved. Prayer requests were shared.

- Tentative enrollment for the 2026-27 school year is 155 students.
- Mrs. Ritchie informed the Board that the search for a part-time Food Services Assistant is ongoing. Applications are still being accepted, and interviews are currently underway. The position is scheduled for Tuesdays through Fridays from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Responsibilities include preparing meals, serving students and staff, cleaning the kitchen and cafeteria areas, and supervising volunteers.
- The Capital Campaign Committee continues working toward the “Faith to the Finish” goal of \$350,000. Reaching this goal will secure an additional \$500,000 and place the school in a good position to construct the gym addition, which was previously estimated at \$620,000. Preparations for Phase I are beginning, including removal of the modular unit, and marketing efforts will help build excitement and encourage further donations. Exciting times at CCA! Continued prayer and financial support are requested as the project moves forward.
- Adam Payne and James Oaks attended the BJU Exchange Conference on July 21-23, with Title II funds covering the professional development opportunity. Both teachers found the conference valuable in strengthening their ability to incorporate a biblical worldview into classroom instruction, engage students, and prepare for the upcoming school year. The experience gave them greater confidence and practical tools for serving CCA students across English, science, Bible, and computer classes. Continued prayer is encouraged for all new staff members as they minister to CCA students and families.

BOARD ACTION & DISCUSSION IN AUGUST

- The Board approved the school insurance proposal from Mike Keith Insurance Co., with a total premium of \$47,178, effective September 1, 2026. The Board was pleased that the premium represents an increase of only 7% over last year.
- The Board approved the proposed budget for the 2026-27 school year. Revenues and Expenditures are estimated at \$1,237,428.
- The Board approved the 2026-27 Faculty Handbook.
- The Board approved Marrone’s Inc. as the food vendor for the 2026-27 school year.
- The Board and Administration reviewed student enrollment for the new school year and prayed for the students, families, and staff. The Administration also provided an update on plans to form a teacher committee during the first semester to evaluate the school’s current discipline policy and compare it with policies used by other Christian schools. The committee’s findings and recommendations will be presented to the Board upon completion of its work.
